**We welcome people who represent the diversity in our community**, particularly those who:

- ✓ Are current or former participants, volunteers or friends of Applegrove
- ✓ Live or work in our catchment (Jones to Woodbine, railway tracks north of Gerrard to the lake)
- ✓ Are members of communities that experience barriers to equal access, opportunities and resources due to disadvantage and discrimination, particularly diverse racial and ethnocultural communities, Indigenous communities, people with disabilities and people living with low income
- ✓ Are youth or young adults over age 18

We are also seeking people with experience and expertise in finance/accounting and seniors issues.

Meetings take place on the last Monday evening of the month. Members attend meetings, join at least one committee and attend events, putting in about 5-10 hours per month. Applegrove is an agency of the City of Toronto and a non-profit organization. Board members therefore sit on two boards: a Board of Directors responsible for the whole organization and a Board of Management responsible for the City agency.

**The closing date for applications is February 28, 2023.** Prospective candidates will be:

- a. Asked to fill in a nomination form
- b. Invited to attend a board or committee meeting as an observer
- c. Interviewed by members of the board's Nomination Committee
