Applegrove is an agency of the City of Toronto and a non-profit organization. Board members therefore sit on two boards: 1) a Board of Directors responsible for the whole organization, and 2) a Board of Management responsible for the City agency. Meetings take place on the last Monday evening of the month. Members attend meetings, join at least one committee and attend events, putting in about 6-10 hours per month.

**The closing date for applications is March 1, 2022.** Prospective candidates will be:

- a. Asked to fill in a nomination form
- b. Invited to attend a board or committee meeting as an observer
- c. Interviewed by members of the board’s Nomination Committee
